2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §4833-A is enacted to read:**

6 **§4833-A. Reimbursement of fee**

8 A municipality may submit to the Maine Waste Management
10 Agency evidence, in writing, of the amount paid in fees imposed
12 by this chapter by people living within that municipality for
14 major appliances and tires purchased and disposed of within that
16 municipality. The Maine Waste Management Agency shall reimburse
18 that municipality for 50% of the amount deposited by that
20 municipality in the Maine Solid Waste Management Fund each
22 calendar year. A municipality receiving funds under this section
shall maintain records of all receipts and expenditures for a
minimum of 3 years.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill allows municipalities to be reimbursed for 50% of
22 solid waste disposal fees deposited in the Maine Solid Waste
Management Fund.
