The Electricians' Examining Board will incur some minor additional costs to adopt new rules relating to the installation of electric hot water heaters and electric water pumps. These costs can be absorbed within the board's existing budgeted resources.'

The bill allows plumbers and electricians to install and do the wiring on water pumps and water heaters.

This amendment eliminates electricians from the bill and adds pump installers. This amendment limits the authority of plumbers to the disconnection and connection of wiring required in pump and heater replacement in residential properties and limits the authority of pump installers to pump replacement.
