apply for grant funds from the Department of Education to 2 implement school choice programs but are not required to participate in the program.

The demonstration sites are eligible for any innovative educational grant funds available within the department. If the department decides to provide grants for these sites and if additional General Fund appropriations are not provided for these grants, these funds may need to be diverted from other intended uses.

The net effect on the costs of participating local school units can not be determined at this time.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment is a minority report. This amendment 18 replaces the bill. The amendment requires the Commissioner of Education to designate 2 pilot sites to implement public school 20 choice programs. The 2 pilot sites must be chosen from among partnerships of school administrative units established to 22 demonstrate efficiencies of consolidating certain school functions. The demonstration sites are eligible to apply for 24 grant funds made available by the Department of Education.
