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'FISCAL NOTE

The Bureau of Insurance will incur some minor additional 4 costs to administer new form filings. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.

Since the State is not required to make any changes to its 8 employee health insurance program as a result of a mandated offer, no additional costs to state departments and agencies will 10 result.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill with a mandated offer of 16 coverage for mental health services performed by licensed counseling professionals. The amendment requires that nonprofit 18 hospital and medical service organizations and insurers make available coverage for mental health services provided by 20 counselors in individual and group contracts at the option of the policyholder. It applies to all contracts executed or renewed on 22 or after January 1, 1997.
