COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 41, L.D. 71, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Charter of the Port Clyde Water District"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 3rd line from the end (page 1, line 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "to" and inserting in its place the following: 'to in'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 2, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", except that the increase of the total indebtedness from \$100,000 to \$250,000 takes effect"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 6th line (page 2, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", resident in the district,"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 12th line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "voters and, for" and inserting in its place the following: 'voters. For'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the last indented paragraph in the 2nd line (page 2, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the Village of Port Clyde in"

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires the Village of Port Clyde to hold a public referendum. The additional costs of this state mandate are relatively minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the 2/3
