34	The additional costs to handle any complaints resulting from the involvement of the constitutional officers and State Auditor
36	in political action committees can be absorbed by the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices utilizing existing
38	budgeted resources.'
40	STATEMENT OF FACT
42	This amendment removes the word "candidate" and replaces it
44	with the words "any individual" because the statutory definition of candidate in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A does not
46	include constitutional officers. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
