Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7107-A, sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 574, §13, is amended to read:

B. In 1995 and 1996, the commissioner shall establish by rule the length of the special muzzle-loading season. The commissioner may establish seasons of different lengths in different regions of the State. The season may extend for no more than 12 hunting days in any part of the State, 6 days immediately before and 6 days immediately following the regular deer hunting season; and

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows muzzle-loading open season on deer to begin 6 days prior to and extend 6 days after the regular deer hunting season.
