An Act to Change Reimbursement Policy on Mental Health Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 24 MRSA §2303, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1987, c. 80, 4 §1, is further amended to read:

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6 2. Mental health services provided by psychologists, social workers or licensed clinical professional certified 8 counselors. Notwithstanding any provision of a contract between subscriber and a nonprofit hospital or medical service а 10 organization entered into pursuant to a hospital service plan, medical service plan or health care plan authorized under this 12 chapter, and notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, whenever the contract provides for payment or reimbursement for 14mental health services, payment or reimbursement for the provision of these services shall may not be denied because the services are provided by a contracting licensed psychologist who 16 . is trained and received a doctorate in psychology specializing in 18 the evaluation and treatment of human behavior, a contracting certified social worker licensed for the independent practice of social work in this State who has at least a masters degree in 20 social work from an accredited educational institution, has been 22 employed in social work for at least 2 years, and who, after January 1, 1985, must be licensed as a clinical social worker in 24 this State₇- Θ ; a contracting licensed nurse who is trained and has received a certificate as а clinical specialist in 26 psychiatric and mental health nursing from the American Nurses' Association, acting within the scope of his that license or 28 certification; or a licensed clinical professional counselor licensed by the State pursuant to Title 32, chapter 119. Subject to approval by the Superintendent of Insurance pursuant to 30 sections 2305 and 2316, a nonprofit hospital or medical service 32 organization incorporated under this chapter shall offer contracts to psychologists licensed pursuant to Title 32, section 34 3831, subsection 27; certified social workers licensed for the independent practice of social work who have at least a masters 36 degree in social work from an accredited educational institution, who have been employed in social work for at least 2 years, and 3.8 who, after January 1, 1985, must be licensed as a clinical social worker in this State, -and; licensed nurses who are certified by 40the American Nurses' Association as clinical specialists in adult psychiatric and mental health nursing or as clinical specialists in child and adolescent psychiatric and mental health nursing; or 42 licensed clinical professional counselors licensed by the State pursuant to Title 32, chapter 119, authorizing the provision of 44 mental health services by these psychologists, clinical social workers, certified social workers and, certified nurses and 46licensed clinical professionals within the scope of their licensure or certification, if the nonprofit hospital or medical 48service organization provides mental health services in contracts with subscribers. Payment or reimbursement for services rendered 50

by clinical social workers or licensed clinical professional counselors licensed in this State shall may not be conditioned 2 upon prior diagnosis or referral by a physician or other health 4 care professional, except in cases where when diagnosis of the condition for which the services are rendered is beyond the scope 6 of their licensure. With--respect--to--services--provided--by psychologists, - this - subsection - applies - to - all - contracts - between 8 the--subseriber--and--a--nonprofit--hospital--or--medical--service organization-entered-into-or-renewed-after-January-1,-1976.

Payment or reimbursement for services rendered by 46 clinical social or licensed clinical professional workers counselors licensed in this State shall may not be conditioned 48 upon prior diagnosis or referral by a physician or other health care professional, except in cases where when diagnosis of the

condition for which the services are rendered is beyond the scope 2 of their licensure.
