COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 53, L.D. 82, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Limit on the Extradition Account"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 15 MRSA §224-A, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 843, §11, is amended to read:

**3. Review by district attorney.** The district attorney shall regularly review monthly the Extradition Account and the expenses of his that prosecutorial district in connection with the extradition of fugitives from justice and shall determine whether any funds in the account shall must be transferred to the General Fund.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The increase in the balances that may be held in Extradition Accounts in each prosecutorial district will reduce General Fund revenue from forfeited bail. The amounts can not be estimated at this time.'

**COMMITTEE AMENDMENT**

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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4           This amendment requires the district attorney to review the  
6 amount in the Extradition Account every month to determine if  
8 there are excess funds in the account that must be transferred to  
the General Fund.

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          This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
