20	This bill will increase the fee for processing excise tax
30	collections by individual agents to the same amount allowed to be charged by municipalities that act as collection agents. This
32	fee increase may result in slight reductions of dedicated revenue to the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund,
34	reducing funding to certain counties by minor amounts. Since this is an excise tax issue and not a new property tax exemption,
36	no reimbursement is required by the State.'
