	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4401, sub-§2-A, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 404, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
6	A. Inundated by surface or ground water to an average depth of 6 inches for a period of 21 consecutive days during the
8	growing season; and

14 16	This bill changes the definition of freshwater wetland by determining a depth and duration of water inundation of the soil rather than by what vegetation the area that is inundated or saturated supports.

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
