2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15903-A is enacted to read:**

6 **§15903-A. Ownership of plans and specifications**

8 Building plans and specifications for school facilities, the
10 construction costs of which are paid for in whole or in part with
12 state money, are the property of the State and the department
14 shall make them available to school administrative units.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 Under this bill, building plans and specifications for
school facilities funded by the State are state property
available for use by all Maine school districts.
