Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1812-G is enacted to read:
<u>§1812-G. School bus purchases</u>
All school bus purchases approved under Title 20-A, section 5401, subsection 15 must be made through the Bureau of General Services. The bureau shall make all bus purchases in accordance
with section 1812.
Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §5401, sub-§15, ¶E is enacted to read:
E. All school bus purchases must be made through the Bureau of General Services.
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill requires all school units or administrative
districts to go through the Bureau of General Services for school bus purchases.
