2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1812-G is enacted to read:**

6 **§1812-G. School bus purchases**

8 All school bus purchases approved under Title 20-A, section
10 5401, subsection 15 must be made through the Bureau of General
12 Services. The bureau shall make all bus purchases in accordance
14 with section 1812.

16 **Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §5401, sub-§15, ¶E is enacted to read:**

18 E. All school bus purchases must be made through the Bureau
20 of General Services.

22 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill requires all school units or administrative districts to go through the Bureau of General Services for school bus purchases.
