Resolve, to Extend the Deadline to Report for the Commission on the Future of Maine's Paper Industry.

Whereas,** Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, Resolve 1993, chapter 75 established the Commission on the Future of Maine's Paper Industry, whose duties include the study of issues relating to the future of the industry; and

Whereas, the commission is to submit its report on these studies to the joint standing committee of the 117th Legislature having jurisdiction over these matters by January 15, 1995; and

Whereas, the commission needs additional time to complete its study and the study deadline must be extended; and

16 Whereas, this extension must occur before the expiration of the 90-day period; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Resolve 1993, c. 75, §9, amended. Resolved: That Resolve 1993, c. 75, §9, is amended to read:

Sec. 9. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall submit its report, together with any necessary implementing legislation,
to the First Regular Session of the 117th Legislature, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction
over housing and economic development matters and to the Maine Economic Growth Council as established under the Maine Revised
Statutes, Title 10, section 929-A no later than January-15 March 8, 1995.

; and be it further

40 Sec. 2. Retroactivity. Resolved: That this resolve applies retroactively to January 15, 1995.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

48 This resolve extends the deadline for when the Commission on the Future of Maine's Paper Industry is to report to the 50 appropriate joint standing committee of the 117th Legislature.

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
