

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 60, L.D. 96, Bill, "An Act to Exempt Owners of Shooting Ranges from any Civil or Criminal Action Relating to Noise Pollution"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§2806." in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or who owns" and in the 2nd line (page 1, line 38 in amendment) by striking out the following: "permanently located" and inserting in its place the following: 'previously existing' and in the 6th line (page 1, line 42 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "range" the following: 'since the person acquired title'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment removes language that prevents a person who owned property before a shooting range was established from maintaining a nuisance action unless there is a substantial change in use of the range.
