2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1973, sub-§6** is enacted to read:

6 6. Rumble strips. The authority shall provide for the  
8 installation and maintenance of rumble strips at each toll  
10 facility on the turnpike.

12 **Sec. 2. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from the  
14 Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
