Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follow

Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §1058 is enacted to read:

§1058. Payment in lieu of property taxes

The Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court may enter into an agreement with the municipal officers of a municipality where judicial administrative offices exempt from taxation under Title 36, Part 2 are located to make payments in lieu of property taxes with regard to those offices. The Chief Justice and the municipal officers shall negotiate the amount of the payment. The Chief Justice may make payment from any funds available to the Judicial Department. This section does not apply to property that is used for judicial proceedings.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes the Judicial Department to make payments in lieu of property taxes on buildings used for administrative purposes. The bill does not apply to property used for judicial purposes.
