	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-L, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
4	393, §1, is amended to read:
6	1. Licensed clinical social workers and licensed clinical
	professional counselors. Licensed clinical social workers must
8	be eligible to receive Medicaid reimbursement for counseling
	services whenever licensed clinical professional counselors are
10	eligible to be reimbursed for those services. Licensed clinical
	professional counselors must be eligible to receive Medicaid
12	reimbursement for counseling services whenever licensed clinical
	social workers are eligible to be reimbursed for those services.
14	<u>Reimbursement may not be conditioned upon practice within a</u>
	hospital or clinic if the services rendered are within the scope
16	of licensure of the provider of the services.
