SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 102, L.D. 137, Bill, "An Act to Create a Purple Heart License Plate"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4 by inserting before the last blocked paragraph (page 2, line 37 in amendment) 2 new blocked paragraphs to read:

'A Purple Heart recipient who does not operate a motor vehicle or register a motor vehicle and who otherwise qualifies for the issuance of special Purple Heart registration plates may apply to the Secretary of State for a special single plate recognizing that person's award.

The Secretary of State shall design and identify these single plates for recognition purposes only. Single Purple Heart plates may not be attached to a motor vehicle. Only one plate may be issued to each recipient and a one-time fee of \$5 charged.'

FISCAL NOTE

The Bureau of Motor Vehicles within the Department of the Secretary of State will incur some minor additional costs to design and issue a special single Purple Heart plate. These costs can be absorbed within the bureau's existing budgeted resources.


