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Sec. 1. 12 MRSA c. 621, sub-c. II, art. 1-A, as amended, is repealed.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill repeals the laws requiring that applicants for handfishing scallop licenses and handfishing sea urchin licenses successfully complete a commercial underwater handharvesting competency course.
