Resolve, to Establish a Pilot Project for Medicaid Reimbursement for Acupuncture Treatment of Substance Abuse.

Sec. 1. Acupuncture pilot project. Resolved: That the Department of Human Services shall undertake a pilot project that provides 2 reimbursement, to the maximum extent allowable, under the United States Social Security Act, Title XIX, for alcoholism and drug 4 dependency treatment by means of acupuncture. The pilot project must be located at the Westbrook Hospital in the City of 6 Westbrook and must begin on October 4, 1995 and last for 2 years. The Department of Human Services shall submit a report on 8 the acupuncture pilot project to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over human resource matters 10 by January 1, 1998.
