This amendment amends the state minimum wage and places additional responsibilities on the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards in the area of required distribution of posters. A General Fund appropriation of \$11,259 in fiscal year 1995-96 is required for publishing costs and other operating expenses related to revising the minimum wage poster.

The increases in the minimum wage may result in increased costs to municipalities if there are school and other public employees who are compensated at less than the higher minimum wage levels. Increased school expenses may increase funding requests for the General Purpose Aid for Local Schools program.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that the state minimum wage will increase to \$4.55 per hour in 1996, \$4.85 per hour in 1997 and \$5.15 per hour in 1998 or to the level of the federal minimum wage, if that is higher, up to a maximum of \$5.15 per hour.
