SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 120, L.D. 155, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1995"

Amend the amendment by adding at the end before the emergency clause the following:

**PART I**

**Sec. I-1. Transfer from Rainy Day Fund.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller is authorized to transfer \$2,400,000 from the Rainy Day Fund to the General Fund undedicated revenue no later than March 1, 1995.

**Sec. I-2. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

**FISCAL NOTE**

**Appropriations/Allocations**

General Fund \$2,400,000

**Revenues**

General Fund \$2,400,000

This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the bill by \$2,400,000 in fiscal year 1994-95. A \$2,400,000 transfer from the Rainy Day Fund to the General Fund undedicated revenue is also authorized in fiscal year 1994-95 so that a balanced General Fund budget is maintained.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment appropriates additional funds to the Community Based Corrections program in the Department of Corrections. This program reimburses counties for the costs associated with housing state prisoners. This program was reduced by approximately \$2,400,000 by the 116th Legislature.

Funding for the General Fund appropriations is provided by transferring available funds from the Rainy Day Fund in fiscal year 1994-95.
