SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 120, L.D. 155, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1995"

Amend the amendment by adding at the end a new part to read:

PART I

Sec. I-1. PL 1993, c. 410, Pt. EEE, §1 is repealed.

Sec. I-2. Transfer from Rainy Day Fund. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller is authorized to transfer \$9,600,000 from the Rainy Day Fund to the General Fund undedicated revenue no later than May 31, 1995.

Sec. I-3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

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This amendment will increase the General Fund cost of the
committee amendment by \$9,600,000 in fiscal year 1994-95. A
\$9,600,000 transfer from the Rainy Day Fund to General Fund
undedicated revenue is also authorized in fiscal year 1994-95 so
that a balanced General Fund budget is maintained.

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This amendment will increase the Highway Fund cost of the
committee amendment by \$3,800,000 in fiscal year 1994-95.
Highway Fund revenues in fiscal year 1994-95 were just
reprojected upward by \$5,110,253, leaving sufficient resources to
maintain a balanced Highway Fund budget.

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
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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment repeals the provision of law that would push the last fiscal year 1994-95 state employee payrolls into July 1995.

The General Fund cost of \$9,600,000 is funded by authorizing a \$9,600,000 transfer in fiscal year 1994-95 from the Rainy Day Fund to the General Fund. The Highway Fund cost of \$3,800,000 is funded using available, unbudgeted resources.
