employees and teachers during the current biennium by a total of \$3,147,800 in fiscal year 1995-96 and \$4,197,050 in fiscal year 1996-97.

Additional General Fund appropriations of \$1,497,800 and \$1,997,050 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, are 6 required for the teachers' retirement portion. General Fund 8 appropriations of \$825,000 and \$1,100,000 and Highway Fund allocations of \$247,500 and \$330,000 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, are required in the salary plan reserve 10 accounts to fund the increases for state employees. The cost to accounts in other funds, estimated to be \$577,500 and \$770,000, 12 may require increased allotments to meet these additional 14 personal services expenditures.'
