2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §285, sub-§11** is enacted to read:

6 **11. Supplemental coverage; Medicare-eligible retirees.** For those retirees who are eligible for coverage under this section, and who are also eligible for Medicare, the Maine State Retirement System shall pay 100% of the retirees' share of the premiums for Medicare Part B only.

10 **Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§6** is enacted to read:

12 **6. Supplemental coverage; Medicare-eligible retired teachers.** For those retired teachers who are eligible for coverage under this section, and who are also eligible for Medicare, the Maine State Retirement System shall pay 100% of the retirees' share of the premiums for Medicare Part B only.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill requires the Maine State Retirement System to pay Medicare Part B premiums for state retirees and retired teachers.
