HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 72, L.D. 160, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Pertaining to Governmentally Constructed Jetties"


Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S480-W.~~" in the first paragraph in the 4th line (page 1, line 39 in amendment) by striking out the following: "coastal sand dune system" and inserting in its place the following: 'sand beach area affected by a governmentally erected jetty'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S480-W.~~" by inserting at the end the following:

'For purposes of this section, "sand beach area affected by a governmentally erected jetty," includes any sand beach area within a 2-mile radius of such a jetty.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment defines for the purposes of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 480-W what area affected by the governmental jetty is included in the meaning of protected property.
