Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Research Institute for Semiological Mathematics; conferring
degrees. The Research Institute for Semiological Mathematics, by
appropriate action of its board of directors, may confer upon
those who successfully complete such requirements as the board of
directors may prescribe the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in
Semiological Mathematics.
