2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 33 MRSA §1871, sub-§3** is enacted to read:

6 **3. Disposal of bicycles; exempt.** For the purposes of this
8 subchapter, a local legislative body in a municipality may
10 dispose of bicycles determined to be abandoned, as defined in
12 section 803, in a manner decided by that body and is exempt from
14 all other provisions of this subchapter.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill exempts bicycles from most of the provisions of
16 the Unclaimed Property Act and enables local municipalities to
dispose of bicycles as they wish and keep any proceeds.
