COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 138, L.D. 186, Bill, "An Act to Permit Full-time Deputies To Hold Local Public Office"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 6 to 8 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'2. **Full-time deputies.** No A full-time deputy may not hold ~~the--municipal--office--of--selectman,--city--councillor--or--budget~~ ~~committee--member--or~~ any other elective or appointive county office or a state office.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment retains the removal of the restrictions on full-time deputies holding certain municipal offices contained in the original bill and clarifies that they may not hold any county office other than full-time deputy sheriff.
