4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §355, sub-§2**, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104,
Pt. A, §9 and Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read:

6 **2. Full-time deputies.** No A full-time deputy may not hold
8 ~~the municipal office of selectman, city councillor or budget~~
~~committee member or any other~~ county office or a state office.
