Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §517, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

7. County sheriff vehicles. Upon the request of a county sheriff, the Secretary of State shall issue special brown numerical registration plates for vehicles owned by the county and used by the sheriff's office. The special sheriff registration plates must contain numbers corresponding to the agency identification number for the county in which the sheriff serves.

This bill creates a special registration plate for vehicles used by sheriffs' offices. The plates are brown and bear numbers corresponding to the agency identification number of the county sheriff's office.
