2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §517, sub-§7** is enacted to read:

6 7. County sheriff vehicles. Upon the request of a county
8 sheriff, the Secretary of State shall issue special brown
10 numerical registration plates for vehicles owned by the county
12 and used by the sheriff's office. The special sheriff
14 registration plates must contain numbers corresponding to the
16 agency identification number for the county in which the sheriff
18 serves.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill creates a special registration plate for vehicles
20 used by sheriffs' offices. The plates are brown and bear numbers
corresponding to the agency identification number of the county
sheriff's office.
