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4.6	This bill establishes a funding mechanism for the Landowner Relations Program. It requires hunters, anglers and trappers to purchase a landowner relations stamp and to carry it on their
48	persons while hunting, fishing or trapping. Proceeds from the
50	sale of this stamp go to the newly created Landowner Relations Fund. The fund may be spent only to further the goals of the
