COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 150, L.D. 198, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Law Regarding Mandatory Insurance Coverage for Mental Illness"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 24 MRSA §2325-A, sub-§5-C, as amended by PL 1993, c. 586, §1, is further amended by amending the last blocked paragraph to read:

This subsection is repealed July 1, 1995 1996.

Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA §2843, sub-§5-C, as amended by PL 1993, c. 586, §3, is further amended by amending the last blocked paragraph to read:

This subsection is repealed July 1, 1995 1996.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment extends the statutory provisions authorizing insurance coverage for certain mental health treatments until July 1, 1996. Under current law, the provisions will be repealed July 1, 1995.
