An Act to Clarify the Laws Regarding the Sale of Recreational Vehicles on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §3203, as amended by PL 1979, c. 127, §124, 4 is further amended to read:

6 §3203. Sales of motor vehicles prohibited

Any person who shall-eaffy carries on or engage engages in 8 the business of buying, selling, exchanging, dealing or trading in new or used motor vehicles; or who shall-open opens any place 10 of business or lot wherein he the person attempts to or does 12 engage in the business of buying, selling, exchanging, dealing or trading in new or used motor vehicles; or who does buy, sell, 14 exchange, deal or trade in new or used motor vehicles as a business on the first day of the week, commonly known and designated as Sunday, is a disorderly person. Such a disorderly 16 person upon conviction for the first offense shall must be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment for 18 not more than 10 days, or by both; and for the 2nd offense shall must be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by 20 imprisonment for not more than 30 days, or by both; and for the 22 3rd or each subsequent offense shall must be punished by a fine of not more than \$750 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or by both. If the person is the holder of dealer or 24 transporter registration plates under Title 29 29-A, chapter 5 9, subchapter III-A III, such person shall-be is subject to the 2.6 suspension or revocation of said those plates, as provided for in Title 29 29-A, section 350-A 903, for the violation of this 28 Recreational vehicle dealers are exempt from this section. 30 section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill makes changes consistent with the recodification of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29 to Title 29-A and also makes recreational vehicle dealers exempt from the Sunday sales prohibition.
