SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 178, L.D. 226, Bill, "An Act to Strengthen the Laws Pertaining to Poaching"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 4 to 6.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the provisions in Committee Amendment "A" that allow the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to suspend a license for more than the existing maximum period of 5 years and removes the provisions that allow the commissioner to suspend any hunting or fishing license held by a person for a single violation.
