Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1991, c. 591,
4 Pt. T, §4, is further amended to read:

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5. Fee. The fee for a shellfish license is \$63. The fee
is \$40 for any holder of a municipal shellfish conservation
8 program license, as defined in section 6671.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill allows holders of a municipal shellfish
conservation program license to pay a reduced fee of \$40 for a
shellfish license.

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
