2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
4	Whereas, Public Law 1993, chapter 158 established the Child
6	Care Advisory Council to advise the Legislature and the Department of Human Services regarding child care services,
8	including an examination of the role and funding of the resource development centers; and

12	Whereas, funding for the resource development centers is due to expire on June 30, 1995; and
14	Whereas, the resource development centers need to be
	continued in order for the council to adequately examine the
16	centers and prepare and present its findings in a 3rd annual report due January 15, 1996 to the Commissioner of Human Services
18	and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having
20	jurisdiction over human resource matters; and
	Whereas, the extension of funding must occur before the
22	expiration of the 90-day period; and
