SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 194, L.D. 253, Bill, "An Act Concerning Municipal Shellfish Conservation Program Penalties"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in the last blocked paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section" and inserting in its place the following: 'paragraph'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects a reference in the bill. It provides that a court may not impose a penalty other than the monetary payment of a fine for a violation of a paragraph of the municipal shellfish ordinance statutes that addresses the penalty for harvesting shellfish from a closed area or digging shellfish without a municipal license.
