2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §584-A, sub-§4**, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 570,  
is amended to read:

6 **4. Ozone.** ~~Photochemical--oxidant~~ Ozone concentration for  
any 1-hour period at any location shall ~~shall~~ may not exceed 160  
8 ~~micrograms-per-cubic-meter~~ .12 parts per million, except once per  
year.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 Currently, the state ambient air quality standard for ozone  
is .08 parts per million, and the federal standard is .12 parts  
16 per million. This bill makes the state ambient air quality  
standard for ozone the same as the federal standard.
