An Act to Change from 2% to 5% the Percentage of the Amount Paid to County Jails from the Government Operations Surcharge Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §1057, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1991, c. 733, 4 §3, is further amended to read:

Reimbursement to counties. Monthly, the Treasurer of 6 3. State shall make payments from this fund to each county in the 8 same proportion as the total amount paid to that county from the total amount deposited into the fund during the fiscal year 10 ending June 30, 1991 bears to the total amount deposited into the fund during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991, except that a 12 county may not receive an amount greater than the prior year's expenditures on its jail. The amount of total payments made to 14 counties must equal 2% 5% of the total fines, forfeitures and penalties, including this surcharge, received by the Treasurer of The balance remaining in the Government Operations 16 State. Surcharge Fund at the end of each month must accrue to the 18 General Fund.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the percentage from 2% to 5% of the 24 amount paid to county jails from the Government Operations Surcharge Fund.
