Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 19 MRSA §317, sub-§3, $\P J$, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 834, Pt. A, is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill repeals one of the criteria allowing a deviation from the child support table used in determining the appropriate amount of child support for which a parent is responsible. The criterion deleted is the amount of resources available to the responsible parent from a domestic associate or current spouse of that responsible parent. This ensures that the parent, not the parent's current spouse or associate, is responsible for payment of the child support.
