- Sec. 1. New England Regional Commission on Fiscal and Public
 Policy established; purpose. Resolved: That the New England Regional
 Commission on Fiscal and Public Policy, referred to in this
 resolve as the "commission," is established to develop fiscal and
 public policies that are beneficial to all New England states;
 and be it further
- Sec. 2. Appointment. Resolved: That the commission consists of 6 members:
- Three Senators, 2 Republicans and one Democrat,
 appointed by the President of the Senate; and

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- 2. Three members of the House of Representatives, 2
 Republicans and one Democrats, appointed by the Speaker of the
 House of Representatives.
- The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall coordinate their appointments and promptly notify the Legislative Council of the appointments; and be it further
- Sec. 3. Convening of the commission. Resolved: That, when the appointment of the commission members is complete, the Executive Director of the Legislative Council shall call the first meeting no later than October 1, 1995. At the first meeting, the members shall elect a chair; and be it further
- Sec. 4. Interstate cooperation. Resolved: That the commission is
 directed to cooperate fully with officials, Legislators and
 citizens of other New England states to develop fiscal and public
 policies that are beneficial to all New England states; and be it
 further
- Sec. 5. Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall meet with members of the comparable commissions established by law within other New England states to:
- Review fiscal and public policies of each participating
 state;
- 42 2. Assess the future demand for fiscal and public policies and develop a process to evaluate those policies;
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- 3. Discuss and evaluate fiscal and public policies that may adversely affect a participating state; and
- 48 4. Recommend any legislation necessary to carry out the commission's findings.

create subcommittees or advisory groups for conducting the commission's business; and be it further Sec. 6. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall report annually to the Legislature and the Governor the results of its efforts, including any recommendations to carry out the purpose of the commission. The commission may submit implementing legislation with an annual report; and be it further Sec. 7. Assistance. Resolved: That the commission may seek staffing assistance and consult state departments with expertise in subjects pertinent to the commission's purpose; and be it further Sec. 8. Compensation. Resolved: That the members of the commission who are Legislators are entitled to receive the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, for each day's attendance at commission meetings; and be it further Sec. 9. Expiration of commission; final report. Resolved: That upon the conclusion of the commission shall submit its final report and, if necessary, legislation to extend the commission; and be it further Sec. 10. Reciprocal legislation. Resolved: That this resolve becomes effective only if similar legislation is enacted by at least one other New England Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
