## An Act to Reduce from 5 to 2 the Number of Ice-fishing Lines That May Be Fished by One Person.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7572, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1989, c. 493,
4	§45, is further amended to read:
6	1. Two-line limit. Unless otherwise provided by rule, a person licensed to fish may fish through ice in the daytime with
8	not more than $5 2$ lines set or otherwise, which shall must be under that person's immediate supervision, in any waters which
10	that have been opened to ice fishing by the commissioner.
12	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7572, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1993, c. 438, §35, is further amended to read:
14	2. Cusk. Unless otherwise provided by rule, a person
16	licensed to fish may fish through the ice in the nighttime for cusk in waters that have been opened pursuant to section 7571,
18	subsection 2, by using not more than 5 $\underline{2}$ lines set or otherwise. All lines set for cusk in the nighttime must be visited at least
20	once every hour by the person setting them.

28	A person is-guilty-of-fishing may fish with not more than 2 lines if-he-fishes-with-more-than-2-lines at any one time,-except that-a-person may-fish-with-more-than-2-lines-in-accordance-with

34	STATEMENT OF FACT
36	This bill reduces the number of fishing lines allowed for ice fishing from 5 to 2, which matches the number of lines allowed for non-ice fishing.
