2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §711, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

6 5. Service additions. When service is provided in
8 accordance with section 2102, subsection 2 and upon request of a
10 utility, the commission shall require joint use of equipment and
12 ensure that such joint use is consistent with the requirements of
14 subsection 1, paragraphs A to C.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill requires the Public Utilities Commission to allow
16 joint use of facilities when 2 or more utilities are providing
service in the same municipality.
