Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the recent, substantial growth in electric load has substantially increased the operating revenues and expenses of the Madison Department of Electric Works; and

Whereas, an increase in short-term borrowing capacity is 10 required to meet any unanticipated short-term obligations and expenses; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1975, c. 53, §9 is amended to read:

Sec. 9. Borrowing for current operating expenses. In addition to
any other borrowing permitted by law, the Town of Madison, by votes of its municipal officers and the board of directors of its
electric works, is authorized to borrow money for current operating expenses and to issue therefor bonds or notes of the
town, not to exceed \$50,000 \$1,200,000. Said bonds and notes shall be paid in not more than 5 years from their date and shall
be legal obligations of said town, and shall be legal investments for savings banks.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the short-term borrowing capacity of the 40 Madison Department of Electric Works to the level necessary for current operations.
