SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 117, L.D. 292, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Chesuncook Soil Series as the Official State Soil"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §§221 and 222 are enacted to read:'


Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'§222. No enhanced protection

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the designation as a state symbol under this subchapter does not confer enhanced protection under the environmental laws or any other applicable laws.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the designation as a state symbol does not confer enhanced protection under the environmental laws or any other applicable laws.
