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Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §4651, as amended by PL 1987, c. 184, §22, is
further amended to read:

§4651. Issue and return

Executions may be issued on a judgment of the Superior Court or the District Court after the judgment has become final by the expiration of the time for appeal, by dismissal of an appeal or on certificate of decision from the law court, unless the court has pursuant to rule ordered execution at an earlier time, and shall-be are returnable within ene-year 3 years after issuance.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that an execution issued on a judgment of the Superior Court or District Court is returnable within 3 years after issuance.
